Reasons why people won't join the church

Nobody's taught them why church membership matters. They had a bad experience with a church. They don't think it is in the Bible.

The main reason people don't become church members is they are afraid we want more from them than we want for them.

What's in it for me? This is the wrong question. What does God want for me?

Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted.18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.
