HINDSIGHT IS 2020

What is your first reaction to hearing God told Hosea to marry a promiscuous woman, and the fact that Hosea obeyed the command?

What struggles do you have when God calls you to love the **unlovable**?

Without sharing names or identity: what makes someone unlovable for you? What makes that same person lovable to God?

Pastor Joe said: Love is more than a feeling. It is a **<u>choice</u>**. Reflect on the many ways God chooses to love you; share with your group. What specific example of God's love for you will you share when telling others about Jesus and God's love?

The Lord named Hosea's children to symbolize judgment against sinful Israel; but He also promised to redeem and restore the nation. See Hosea 2:14-23, note the reversal of their names that shows how God views His children and wants them (us) in a relationship with Him.

Love means not **giving up**. Is there someone in your life that needs to know that God has not given up on them? Ask your group to commit to praying with you for that person. Will you invite him or her to in-person or on-line church for 30 Second Theology next week?
