O HOW DO I HAVE A PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD?

You probably have a lot of questions, and we hope that this book will begin to answer them, plus provide a few resources to help you learn more on your own.

Q WHY WOULD GOD CARE ABOUT ME?

There are 4 things you need to know:

- 1. God loves you
- 2. He chose you
- 3. He has a plan for you
- 4. He desires to have a personal relationship with you.

IF GOD CARES SO MUCH ABOUT ME, WHY DO I FEEL EMPTY SOMETIMES?

We are all created with an ache in our soul to be known and loved by God. He's the only one who can fill this need. God created us for a purpose bigger than ourselves.

We long to have the assurance that even when we make mistakes, we will still be loved, valued, and embraced by God.

'For I know the plans I have for you,' declares the Lord, 'plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you a hope and a future.' - Jeremiah 29:11

WHY DOES GOD OFTEN SEEM SO FAR AWAY?

Despite our desire to be loved, people have always turned their backs on God. We choose to go our own way and live by our own will and disregard biblical truth. The Bible calls this "sin" and we are all guilty of it.

Sin is what keeps us separate from a relationship with God. When we sin and ignore the truth, death is the result.

Sin has a way of killing our relationships, our joy, and our closeness with God. The payment for sin is death and eternal separation from God.

> All have sinned; all fall short of God's glorious standard. – Romans 3:23

CAN I WORK MY WAY BACK TO GOD BY BECOMING A BETTER PERSON?

Because of our sin there is a huge impassable gap between us and God. We try to reconcile with God by being a good person, or by following religious rules to work or earn our way back to God, but no human effort can make us good enough to fix our separation from God.

God, who still deeply loves us, desires to have a personal relationship with us, His creation.

God showed His great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners. - Romans 5:8

I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me. - John 14:6

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith - and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God - not by works, so that no one can boast. - Ephesians 2:8-9

Q THEN HOW DO I GET TO GOD?

Because God loves us so much, his solution was to send His Son, Jesus Christ, to bridge the gap between us.

There is no other way for us to get to God other than through Jesus Christ.

Jesus was fully God and fully human, yet He had no sin. Jesus willingly laid down his life and, three days later, rose from the dead. In His death and resurrection, His life paid the price for our sin once and for all.

DO I HAVE A CHOICE TO ACCEPT GOD'S GIFT?

Yes. We all have a choice. Forgiveness of our sins is a gift from God when we accept Jesus as the one who saved us. We can't earn it and we don't deserve it - it is simply a gift.

A gift isn't a gift until it has been accepted. We must individually accept that Jesus Christ saved us from our sins to receive eternal life.

> If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved. - Romans 10:9-10

When we say yes to Jesus, the Bible says that God gives us eternal life, and this life is found in His son Jesus Christ.

4 QUESTIONS TO ASK:

- 1. Do I know that God loves me and has a plan for my life?
- 2. Do I understand that I've sinned and that my sin is a barrier to my relationship with God?
- 3. Do I believe that Jesus Christ paid the penalty for my sin and is the only way to find forgiveness for my sins?
- 4. Have I accepted Jesus as my Lord and Savior by believing in him - by saying yes to Him?
