Where there is no vision, the people perish. - Proverbs 29:18 KJV

Vision is from God but what fuels vision?

Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. This is what the ancients were commended for. - Hebrews 11:1-2

Through the Holy Spirit we have access to the mind of Christ, which is the source of unlimited ideas.
