When our anger is unresolved, we don't get better. We get bitter.

"You have heard that it was said to the people long ago, 'You shall not murder, and anyone who murders will be subject to judgment.' - Matthew 5:21

But I tell you that anyone who is angry with a brother or sister will be subject to judgment. Again, anyone who says to a brother or sister, 'Raca,' is answerable to the court. And anyone who says, 'You fool!' will be in danger of the fire of hell. - Matthew 5:22

"Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother or sister has something against you, leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to them; then come and offer your gift. - Matthew 5:23-24

4 impacts of unchecked anger:

Anger accelerates
Anger is a spiritual cancer
Unchecked anger can spill out
Judgment also accelerates

We are accountable for what we do in our anger.

Again, anyone who says to a brother or sister, 'Raca,' is answerable to the court. And anyone who says, 'You fool!' will be in danger of the fire of hell. - Matthew 5:22

We are prisoners of our painful anger.

For I see that you are full of bitterness and captive to sin. - Acts 8:23

We must be proactive about our anger.

See to it that no one falls short of the grace of God and that no bitter root grows up to cause trouble and defile many. - Hebrews 12:15

Deal with anger when it is small.

Deal with anger when it is current.

Deal with anger when God shows it to us.

First go and be reconciled to them; then come and offer your gift. - Matthew 5:24

How do we walk away from bitterness?

Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven. - Luke 6:37

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. - 1 John 1:9
