QUESTIONS FOR YOU & GROUP

- 1. Which characters stood out to you most? Which were most interesting? Most moving?
- 2. How did the disciple's reaction to the leper differ than Jesus'? What do you suppose they thought when Jesus approached the leper; when He touched him and when he healed him?
- 3. Leprosy was one of the major diseases in the time of Jesus. It was the sickness that renders a person no longer worthy of dignity, love, or community. Are there any "like" situations in our society today that would cause a person to no longer have dignity? How do you think Jesus would treat them?
- 4. What's holding you back from the kind of bold faith the leper had?
- 5. How can you connect with people in your life who aren't part of the "in" crowd, as Jesus did?
- 6. In order to take such extreme measures, what must the four men, have believed about Jesus before they brought their friend to Him? What might their thoughts have been when He said "stand" to their paralytic friend, and when the man took a step?
- 7. If you were in the crowd that day and heard Jesus teaching, what would you have thought of Him (before He healed the paralytic.)
