The million dollar question: Why Mary and Joseph?

This is the one I will esteem: he who is humble and contrite in spirit, who trembles at My word, Isaiah 66:2b

Nahat

"To esteem, to regard with pleasure, to respect, to be impressed."

The greatness of a person is in the direct proportion to the measure of their surrender in their life.

Then Joseph, her fiancé, being a man of stern principle, decided to break the engagement but to do it quietly, as **he didn't** want to publicly disgrace her. Matthew 1:19

When Joseph woke up, **he did as the angel of the Lord commanded** and took Mary as his wife. But he did not have sexual relations with her until her son was born. And Joseph named him Jesus.

Matthew 1:24-25

In the sixth month of Elizabeth's pregnancy, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a village in Galilee, to a virgin named Mary. She was engaged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of King David. Gabriel appeared to her and said, "Greetings, favored woman! The Lord is with you!" **Luke 1:26-28**

Confused and disturbed, Mary tried to think what the angel could mean. "Don't be afraid, Mary," the angel told her, "for you have found favor with God! **Luke 1:29-30**

You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you will name him Jesus. He will be very great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his ancestor David. And he will reign over Israel forever; his Kingdom will never end!" Luke 1:31-32

Mary asked the angel, "But how can this happen? I am a virgin." The angel replied, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the baby to be born will be holy, and he will be called the Son of God. **Luke 1:34-35**

What's more, your relative Elizabeth has become pregnant in her old age! People used to say she was barren, but she has conceived a son and is now in her sixth month. For the word of God will never fail." **Luke 1:36-37**

Mary responded, "I am the Lord's servant. May everything you have said about me come true." And then the angel left her. Luke 1:38

Why didn't humility and commitment make the cut?

Fruit grows in the soil that is cultivated by humility and fertilized by gratitude.

Humus
